THE AREA BETWEEN THE STARI MOST AND THE KOMADINA BRIDGE

Our investigation focused on the area between the Stari Most and the Komadina bridge, focused equally on the physical issues of the site and the ideological issues raised by the presence of several cultural institutions in primary residential district. We examined several proposals for the site and the ramifications of those proposals on the area & the city.

AARATI KANEKAR, ANDREW HERSCHER,
PAOLA CATTARIN AND NILÜFER BATURAYOĞLU

Our work focused on the Karadzobegova Complex and the urban fabric that surrounded it, which was formed of five city blocks located between the *B.Fejica* and *M.Tita* Streets. We studied the urban fabric transformations in this area from the Ottoman to the Austro-Hungarian periods. At the end of our analysis of these two logic inherent in the layout, we proposed a secondary system of pedestrian circulation that could be developed by defining the latent inner structure of the blocks and connecting various alley-ways. This new system not only connects the mosque complex to the *Carsija* of the old city core but also defines new urban spaces in and around the mosque complex, and thus creating a new complex combining the old and new cemeteries on both sides of the mosque and the institutional buildings located around it.

Accuracy and speed in the decision making process will be essential to the restoration process in Bosnia. Computer technology, especially database systems and the Internet will be a necessary element in this situation. These systems can not only aid reconstruction, but also generate the historical record of its progress.

A PROJECT FOR THE ATIC MAHALLA
CENNARO CASSIANI, GIOVANNA BUCCHIARONE, SANDARA D'URZO

The mahalla we worked on is located nearby city core and defined by the Neretva river on the western side and by B. Fejica on the eastern side. After having studied the continuous transformations in evolution which gave to Atic mahalla its structure we tried to give possible design solution which not only respects this structure but also makes the little corrections where the original urban pattern has not been respected. Atic mahalla is formed having a belt of public buildings protect a more private residential area. In our project we moved a kindergarten which now occupies a residential core into this public belt to preserve the privacy of the residential part, and to provide new houses. Another aim of this project was to give a residential site, needed, clear and more coherent typology-a historic one.

TABAHANA COMPLEX AND BASCINE GARDENS
JAFFER KHAN, TOM SINCAVAGE, MUHSIN HIDIROV AND EBRU GENCER

Tabahane complex and the Bascine Gardens are significant physical entities of the city core of Old Mostar. Tabhana since 1986, has been functioning as a commercial center linking itself to the main commercial spine of Mostar. Tabhana as an economically viable space needs to be restored to its pre-

war commercial vitality. The gardens are the lungs of the Old Town, and it is essential to reserve the green space as part of urban ecology of the town. The tabhana, mosque, proposed hammam and gardens are linked by water, eventually contacting the Neretva river. The courtyard as a micro universe and the gardens as the macro universe enhance the quality of place, sense of identity and contact nature.
